

# YOUTH TALENT TO MARKET



The project seeks to identify a non-formal entrepreneurial training pathway for artisans, who have learnt their craft and now wish to develop their business skills so that they can take their talent to market; either a national or international market

Funded by the Erasmus+ Programme, YT2M project enables Gecko, Cedit and LCYouth to send 60 artists/artisans (20 each) to Florence, Limassol and Wolverhampton for a 14 day workshop, with 30 artists/artisans remaining for a further six weeks work placement.

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## PROJECT TIMELINE

Oct-Dec 2015 - recruitment

Jan 2016 - workshop followed by a work placement in Florence/Limassol/Wolverhampton.

Jan-Mar 2016 - recruitment

June 2016 - workshops followed by a work placement in Limassol/Florence/Wolverhampton.

We are looking to recruit 10 artists/artisans for each workshop from each country. Out of the 10 participants

5 will stay abroad (Florence/Limassol/Wolverhampton) only for the duration

5 will stay abroad (Florence/Limassol/Wolverhampton) for the workshop plus work placement (60 days)



YT2M is a partnership composed of three organisations that work with the creative sector in the UK, in Italy and in Cyprus. The project develops, tests and adopts innovative practices, by providing workshops and work placements in a blended mobility that will support them to develop and sustain a business in this sector.

The project works closely with artisans and artists groups throughout the life of the project, and engages them to contribute to the design of the workshops and the style in which it is presented.

Sixty young artisans will be developed in the pilot, along with nine youth workers being developed as enterprise mentors.
